

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF IOT READY LED LUMINAIRES, CONTROLLERS, AND CENTRAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS (CMS) AT THE ELIDZ UNDER AN ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACT, INCLUDING FULL FINANCING AND SHARED ENERGY SAVINGS OVER THE AGREED CONTRACT PERIOD

The **East London Industrial Development Zone SOC Ltd** is the operator of the East London Industrial Development Zone (ELIDZ), an entity which exists to help manufacturers to become globally competitive through the development and efficient management of a modern, purpose-built industrial location, which offers investing industries a streamlined business environment enhanced by a range of supporting services. The zone is already operational and currently houses a number of manufacturers that supply products for the local and international markets.

ELIDZ is committed to advancing sustainable industrial development through the implementation of innovative energy efficiency solutions that support operational excellence and environmental sustainability. As part of this commitment, ELIDZ intends to implement a Smart Street Lighting Energy Performance Contract (EnPC) to modernise and optimise its existing streetlighting infrastructure.

The project involves retrofitting existing high-pressure sodium (HPS) streetlights with high-efficiency LED lighting technology integrated with an advanced Internet of Things (IoT) control system. The solution will enable smart monitoring, remote management, improved operational performance, and enhanced energy efficiency across ELIDZ's streetlighting network.

Through this initiative, ELIDZ aims to transition its lighting infrastructure towards an Eco-Industrial Park standard by achieving measurable energy savings, reducing operational and maintenance costs, and implementing a performance-based contracting model that links service provider remuneration to verified project outcomes.

SCOPE OF WORK

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced service providers for the **REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, COMMISSIONING, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF IOT READY LED LUMINAIRES, CONTROLLERS AND CENTRAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS (CMS) AT THE ELIDZ UNDER AN ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACT (EnPC), INCLUDING FULL FINANCING AND SHARED ENERGY SAVINGS OVER THE AGREED CONTRACT PERIOD.** The project will be implemented at the ELIDZ facilities located within the West Bank area of the Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipality.

The ELIDZ is aiming to implement a shared-savings energy performance contract. Under this contracting model, the service provider is expected to finance, implement, and maintain the energy efficiency solution and receive repayments linked to verified energy savings achieved over the agreed contract period.

The Services include the following summarized scope of work:

The appointed Energy Services Company (ESCO) shall provide a complete turnkey EnPC solution for the upgrade and optimisation of ELIDZ's existing street lighting infrastructure. The scope shall include the design, financing, supply, installation, commissioning, operation, maintenance, monitoring, and verification of an IoT-enabled smart LED street lighting system, including a shared energy savings mechanism over the agreed contract period.

The services shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Conducting detailed energy assessments, technical surveys, baseline studies, and analysis of the existing street lighting infrastructure to establish current energy consumption, operating conditions, and potential energy efficiency opportunities.
- Developing and implementing a complete energy efficiency solution, including the replacement of existing High-Pressure Sodium (HPS) street lighting infrastructure with energy-efficient IoT-ready LED luminaires, smart controllers, and associated communication technologies.
- Supplying, delivering, installing, testing, and commissioning approximately 415 LED street lighting luminaires, controllers, and associated smart lighting equipment in accordance with the approved technical specifications.
- Implementing a CMS to enable remote monitoring, control, fault detection, optimisation, performance tracking, and management of the installed street lighting network.
- Developing a comprehensive Energy EnPC model, including the proposed financing structure, contract duration, savings-sharing mechanism, performance obligations, operation and maintenance responsibilities, and Measurement and Verification (M&V) methodology.
- Providing full project financing, procurement, logistics, and implementation of the energy efficiency solution, with payments linked to verified energy savings achieved during the contract period.
- Conducting energy savings calculations and submitting a detailed energy performance proposal demonstrating expected energy and maintenance savings, including the assumptions, modelling methodology, and projected performance improvements.
- Developing and implementing an IPMVP-aligned Measurement and Verification (M&V) plan, including baseline methodology, key performance indicators, verification approach, roles and responsibilities, reporting frequency, and procedures for validating achieved savings throughout the EnPC period.
- Providing a detailed project implementation plan covering project methodology, timelines, resource requirements, installation activities, testing, commissioning, and handover of the completed system.
- Ensuring all supplied equipment complies with applicable technical standards, including relevant SANS/IEC certifications, quality requirements, warranties, and performance specifications.
- Providing qualified and experienced resources, including project managers, engineers, technical specialists, financial specialists, operations and maintenance personnel, and M&V specialists required to successfully implement and manage the EnPC.
- Providing ongoing operations, maintenance, monitoring, and optimisation services throughout the EnPC contract duration to ensure sustained performance, reliability of the installed infrastructure, and achievement of guaranteed energy savings.
- Performing preventative and corrective maintenance, including fault resolution, replacement of defective equipment, maintenance scheduling, and maintaining service records for the installed infrastructure.
- Providing monthly monitoring, verification, and performance reports detailing energy consumption, verified savings, system performance, maintenance activities, and compliance with agreed performance targets to support the shared savings payment mechanism.
- Providing technical documentation, including equipment datasheets, drawings, commissioning certificates, operation manuals, maintenance procedures, and as-built documentation upon completion of the project.
- Providing training, knowledge transfer, and technical support to ELIDZ personnel to ensure effective operation and sustainability of the installed smart lighting solution.
- Demonstrating relevant experience in implementing similar LED street lighting and Energy Performance Contract projects, supported by verifiable references and evidence of successful project delivery.
- Ensuring compliance with all applicable statutory, health, safety, environmental, procurement, and ELIDZ requirements, including submission of project specific SHE documentation before commencement of work.

BID CONDITIONS:

- Tenderers are required to submit a Valid SARS Tax Clearance Certificate with their tender, or the relevant SARS pin code which will allow the ELIDZ to confirm the tenderers tax status on-line
- Tenderer must be registered on Central Supplier Database (CSD) from National Treasury and MAAA number must be provided
- Tenderers should submit a Valid original or certified B-BBEE certification. Companies with annual turnover less than R10 million to submit an accountant or SARS letter confirming turnover.
- Tenderers to provide certified copy of Company Registration Certificate
- Tenderers to provide Letter of Good Standing from Compensation Commissioner
- Tenderers must submit technical and financial proposals in two separate envelopes clearly marked "Envelope A -Technical Proposal" and "Envelope B – Financial Proposal". Then the financial proposal will only be opened should the technical proposal be found to be acceptable.
- Non-signed "Form of Offer" the financial proposal in "Envelope B" submission will result in the disqualification of the tender.
- Inclusion of Price Offer and/ or any other price related details in "Envelope A -Technical Proposal "will result in the disqualification of the tender.
- The successful Tenderer will be required to have sufficient and competent staff available to commence full-time operations in accordance with the contract with effect from the Commencement Date, failing which the contract will be awarded to the next most preferred Tender.
- Registration with the CIDB in the category **4EB or 4EP or Higher** is compulsory for companies wishing to submit tenders.
- For Joint Venture a lead partner has a contractor grading designation equal or higher than 3EB/3EP class of construction work or in terms of the CIDB JV Calculator
- Director or (one of the Director's) of the company provide Proof of Valid registration with ECSA as (Pr Tech Eng/ Pr Eng) or Valid registration with SACPCMP as (Pr CM/ PRCPM)
- Submit one (1) successfully completed Energy Performance Contract or equivalent performance-based project
- The following tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being registered prior to submissions, are eligible to submit tenders:
 - Contractors who have a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a 4EP/4EB or higher class of construction work.
 - every member of the joint venture is a registered contractor in terms of these Regulations, and the lead partner has a contractor grading designation of not lower than one level below the required grading designation in the class of construction works under consideration and possesses the required recognition status; and
 - the category of registration of the joint venture, determined in accordance with sub regulation (6) is equal to or higher than the category of registration specified in accordance with sub regulation (3)."
 - A lead partner has a contractor grading designation equal or higher than 3EB/3EP class of construction work; and
 - The combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a 4EP/4EB class of construction work; and
 - A Joint Venture agreement is submitted together with the tender indicating shareholding percentage
 - OR
 - The joint venture calculator sums up the capacity of all the joint venture partners and calculates a grading designation for the joint venture. Notwithstanding the calculated result, the following table summarizes the combinations of designations held by Joint
 - Venture partners which as a result will be deemed to satisfy the requirements for the relevant designation:
 - Three contractors registered in contractor grading designation 3 of which the lead partner must be registered in the class of work under consideration.
 - Or Two contractors registered in contractor grading designation 3 of which one is the lead partner registered in the class of work under consideration plus two contractors registered in contractor grading designation 3 within the class of work under consideration.
 - Or One grade 4 lead partner within the class of work under consideration plus any grade combination contractors in any class of work.
 - A service provider will be required to submit proof of registration of the staff registered with department of labour as an Installation Electrician as per Electrical Machinery Regulation 13(1) to issue the installation certificate of compliance. Failure to submit this document will result in automatic disqualification.
 - A service provider will be required to submit proof of registration with Department of labour as an Electrical Contract, this it is compulsory.

EVALUATION:

The evaluation will be guided by the ELIDZ procurement policy. Points will be awarded on the basis of Price and Specific goals.

Score breakdown:

- 80 Points for financial offer
- 20 Points for Specific goals

All tenders not providing compulsory responsive documentation and with functionality scoring less than 70%, will not be considered for the next stage of tender evaluation

PROPOSAL DOCUMENT & SUBMISSION:
